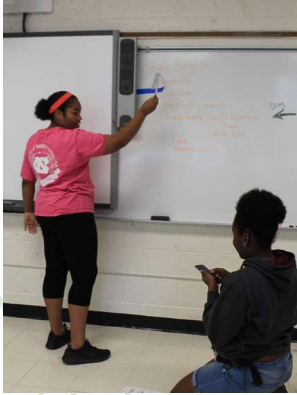
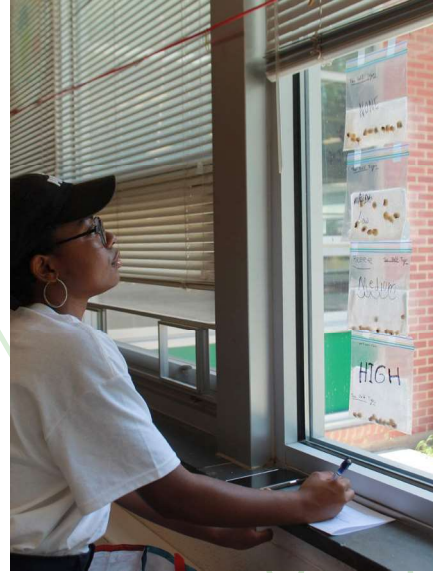
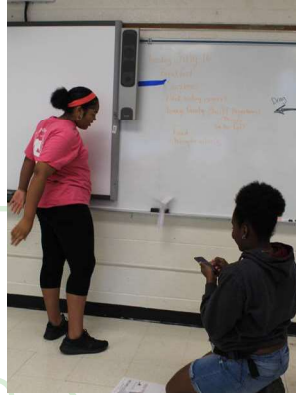


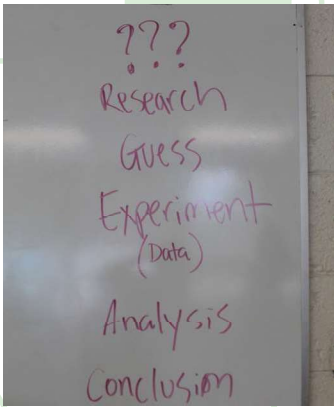
Activities
