Greetings Board Members,

E3 Camp (Empowering Excellence thru Exploration) had its 7th Annual three week camp from July 8th thru 27th at Chapel of the Cross. This free camp provided 27 African-American middle/high school students the opportunity to explore 28 different topics in the Art and STEM fields. Campers experienced 7 educational field trips, hands-on activities and 28 onsite presenters, which were experts in their respective fields.

E3 Camp Board Members want to Thank You - SKJAJA Board - for providing \$2,000 to assist with an educational field to the Historic Stagville Plantation in Durham. Funds assisted with admission tickets and meals for campers, and transportation for the visit. Campers learned that Stagville Plantation was one of the largest areas in NC that had enslaved people. Highest point of the plantation covered 30,000 acres and had 900 enslaved people, who built their lounging cabins and barns that held livestock that was more valuable than them.

After the visit to the Historic Stagville Plantation, students went to a Black Owned Chick-fil-a on Hillsborough Road in Durham for lunch. The owner, Pamela Moncree, came out and discussed the career pathway of owning a business. Wonderful opportunity for them to see someone that looked like them "being the Boss."

E3 Camp wants to show gratitude for SKJAJA's continued support over the last 3 years with funds for educational field trips aligning with our mission of giving youth the opportunities to better themselves.
